

## Utah Code - Public Safety Code 53-7-225.1 - Civil Liability:

1) (a) An individual who negligently, recklessly, or intentionally causes or spreads a fire through discharge of a class C explosive is liable for the cost of suppressing that fire and any damages the fire causes.



### 2018 FIREWORKS SALES AND DISCHARGE DATES

#### Sales

Class "C" fireworks can be sold the following dates:

June 24 – July 25  
December 29 – December 31st  
2 days before and on Chinese New Year's Eve

#### Discharge

Between the hours of 11am and 11pm except as noted:

July 2 – July 5  
(July 4 hours extended to midnight)

July 22 – 25  
(July 24 hours extended to midnight)

December 31\*  
(11am – 1am Jan. 1)

Chinese New Year's Eve  
(11am – 1am the following day)

\*if New Year's eve is on a Sunday and the county, municipality, or metro township determines to celebrate New Year's eve on the prior Saturday (Dec 30), then a person may discharge Class C common state approved explosives on that prior Saturday within the county, municipality, or metro township;
